## Transitional and saving provisions

#### **Government of Wales Act 2006**

- **14.**—(1) Despite its repeal by paragraph 39 of Schedule 3 to EU(W)A 2018, section 113 of GOWA 2006(1) continues to have effect on and after IP completion day in relation to a Bill where—
  - (a) a reference has been made in relation to the Bill under section 112 of GOWA 2006(2) before IP completion day,
  - (b) a reference for a preliminary European Court ruling (within the meaning of section 113 of that Act) has been made before IP completion day by the Supreme Court in connection with that reference, and
  - (c) neither of those references has been decided or otherwise disposed of before IP completion day.
- (2) Where section 113 of GOWA 2006 continues to have effect in relation to a Bill by virtue of paragraph (1), the following do not apply in relation to the Bill—
  - (a) the amendments made to section 111 of GOWA 2006(3) by paragraph 38 of Schedule 3 to EU(W)A 2018, and
  - (b) the amendments made to section 115 of GOWA 2006(4) by paragraph 40 of Schedule 3 to EU(W)A 2018.
