## **ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, ENGLAND**

# The Financial Assistance for Environmental Purposes (England) Order 2020

Made - - - at 10.50 a.m. on 3rd March 2020

Laid before Parliament at 5.00 p.m. on 3rd March 2020

Coming into force - - 30th March 2020

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 153(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990(**a**).

### Citation, commencement, extent and application

- 1. This Order—
  - (a) may be cited as the Financial Assistance for Environmental Purposes (England) Order 2020;
  - (b) comes into force on 30th March 2020; and
  - (c) extends to England and Wales.

### Amendment of section 153(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990

- **2.** In section 153(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990(**b**) (purposes for which financial assistance may be given), after paragraph (nn) insert—
  - "(00) any scheme, programme or organisation for the purpose of preventing or reducing waste or litter in England, or of promoting resource efficiency in England;
  - (pp) any scheme, programme or organisation for the storage, transport, treatment or disposal of any material or product in England for the purpose of preventing or reducing environmental damage.".
