**PUBLIC SERVICE PENSIONS**

**The Judicial Pensions and Fee-Paid Judges' Pension Schemes (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations 2020**

*Made* - - - - 30th March 2020  
*Coming into force* - - 1st April 2020

The Lord Chancellor, as the appropriate Minister within the meaning of section 30(1) of the Judicial Pensions and Retirement Act 1993<sup>(1)</sup> (“the 1993 Act”), and the Secretary of State, as the appropriate Minister within the meaning of that section, make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 18A of the 1993 Act<sup>(2)</sup>.

The Lord Chancellor also makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1 and 3 of, and paragraph 9 of Schedule 3 to, the Public Service Pensions Act 2013<sup>(3)</sup> (“the 2013 Act”).

In accordance with section 22(2)(a) of the 2013 Act, the Lord Chancellor has consulted representatives of such persons as appear to him likely to be affected by these Regulations with a view to reaching agreement with them. In accordance with paragraph 2(2) of Schedule 2 to the 2013 Act, the Lord Chancellor has consulted the Secretary of State.

In accordance with section 22(2)(b) of the 2013 Act, the Lord Chancellor has laid a report before Parliament.

In accordance with section 3(5) of the 2013 Act, these Regulations are made with the consent of the Treasury.

In accordance with section 29(2A) of the 1993 Act<sup>(4)</sup> and section 24(1)(c) of the 2013 Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.
