**The Crown Court (Recording and Broadcasting) Order 2020**

**Recording and broadcasting sentencing remarks**

**4.** Section 41 of the Criminal Justice Act 1925(1) and section 9 of the Contempt of Court Act 1981(2) do not apply where (and only where) sentencing remarks are—

- (a) recorded in accordance with the conditions in articles 5 to 7; or
- (b) broadcast in accordance with the conditions in articles 8 to 10.
