## FOOD, ENGLAND

The Products Containing Meat etc. (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

Made - - - - 15th November 2021
Laid before Parliament 16th November 2021
Coming into force - 12th December 2021

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by—

- (a) sections 6(4), 16(1)(a) and (e), 26(1)(a) and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990(1); and
- (b) sections 114A and 138(7) and (8) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998(2).

So far as these Regulations are made in exercise of powers under the Food Safety Act 1990, the Secretary of State has had regard to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency in accordance with section 48(4A) of the Food Safety Act 1990.

There has been consultation, as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety(3), during the preparation and evaluation of these Regulations.
