**The Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 2022**

**PART 7**

**UNIVERSAL CREDIT**

**Universal Credit**

**33.**—(1) In the table in regulation 22 of the Universal Credit Regulations<sup>(1)</sup> (deduction of income and work allowance)—

- (a) for “£557”, in each place where it occurs, substitute “£573”; and
- (b) for “£335”, in each place where it occurs, substitute “£344”.

(2) The amounts specified in the table in regulation 36 of the Universal Credit Regulations<sup>(2)</sup> (table showing amounts of elements) shall be as set out in Schedule 13 to this Order.

(3) In paragraph 14(1) of Schedule 4 to the Universal Credit Regulations<sup>(3)</sup> (amount of housing cost contributions) for “£75.53” substitute “£77.87”.

(4) In Part 4 of Schedule 5 to the Universal Credit Regulations (calculation of amount of housing costs element for owner-occupiers)—

- (a) in paragraph 10(2) *Step 3*; and
- (b) in paragraph 11(2) *Step 2*,

as those paragraphs have effect in a case falling within regulation 20 of the LMI Regulations 2017<sup>(4)</sup> “£200,000” remains unchanged.
