**General**

**Amendment of the Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019**

**2.** The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019<sup>(1)</sup> are amended as set out in regulations 3 to 11.

**Interpretation**

**3.** In regulation 2 (interpretation), after the definition of “non-government controlled Ukrainian territory” insert—

““OFCOM” means the Office of Communications;”<sup>(2)</sup>.
