The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 12(1) and 32A(3) of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 of the European Parliament and of the Council on novel foods, etc.(1).

#### Citation, commencement, extent and application

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Novel Foods (Authorisations) and Smoke Flavourings (Modification of Authorisations) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2022 and come into force on 29th June 2022.
  - (2) These Regulations extend to England and Wales, but apply in relation to England only.

# Amendment of the Novel Foods (Authorisations) and Smoke Flavourings (Modification of Authorisations) (England) Regulations 2022

- **2.**—(1) The Novel Foods (Authorisations) and Smoke Flavourings (Modification of Authorisations) (England) Regulations 2022(**2**) are amended as follows.
  - (2) In Schedule 3—
    - (a) in the entry for "3'-Sialyllactose (3'-SL) sodium salt (microbial source)", in the third column, after "Maximum levels" insert "(expressed as 3'-Sialyllactose)";
    - (b) in the entry for "6'-Sialyllactose (6'-SL) sodium salt (microbial source)", in the third column, after "Maximum levels" insert "(expressed as 6'-Sialyllactose)".

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Novel Foods (Authorisations) and Smoke Flavourings (Modification of Authorisations) (England) Regulations 2022 (S.I. 2022/560). Those Regulations amend Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/2470 establishing the Union list of novel foods in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 of the European Parliament and of the Council on novel foods (EUR 2017/2470); to add four novel foods and amend the conditions of use and specifications of one novel food on the list of authorised novel foods.

Regulation 2(2) amends the entries for 3'-Sialyllactose sodium salt and 6'-Sialyllactose sodium salt in schedule 3 to S.I. 2022/560 to correct an error in the maximum levels. Regulation 2(3) amends the entry for 6'-Sialyllactose sodium salt in schedule 7 to S.I. 2022/560 to correct a typographical error.

An impact assessment has not been produced for these Regulations as no, or no significant, impact on the public, private or voluntary sector is foreseen.
