The Office for Students, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 42(1) and 44(1) of the Higher Education and Research Act 2017(a), makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Power to Award Degrees etc. (The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd) (Amendment) Order 2022 and shall come into force on 26th September 2022.

Variation of Power to Award Degrees etc. (The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd) Order 2020

- **2.**—(1) The Power to Award Degrees etc. (The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd) Order 2020 is varied in accordance with paragraph (2).
 - (2) For article 2, substitute—
 - "2. The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd shall be competent to grant the following specified taught awards of the kind mentioned in section 42(2)(b) of the said Act:
 - (a) MASc in Interdisciplinary Practice;
 - (b) PGDip in Interdisciplinary Practice;
 - (c) PGCert in Interdisciplinary Practice;
 - (d) BASc (Hons) in Interdisciplinary Problems and Methods;
 - (e) BASc in Interdisciplinary Problems and Methods;
 - (f) DipHE in Interdisciplinary Problems and Methods; and
 - (g) CertHE in Interdisciplinary Problems and Methods.".
