**The Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023
(Revocation and Sunset Disapplication) Regulations 2023**

Savings

- 6.—(1) In this regulation—
- (a) the “2012 Act” means the Legal Aid, Sentencing and Punishment of Offenders Act 2012⁽¹⁾;
 - (b) the “2013 Regulations” means the Civil Legal Aid (Merits Criteria) Regulations 2013⁽²⁾.
- (2) The revocation of any provision of the 2013 Regulations by these Regulations—
- (a) does not affect the application of paragraph 1(a) of Article 69 of the EU withdrawal agreement⁽³⁾; and
 - (b) the revoked provisions continue to have effect for the purposes of that paragraph.
- (3) Paragraph (4) applies to a determination made before the end of 2023 by the Director of Legal Aid Casework, in accordance with Part 1 of the 2012 Act, that an individual qualifies for civil legal services.
- (4) In relation to a determination to which this paragraph applies, the revocation of any provision of the 2013 Regulations by these Regulations—
- (a) does not affect the application of section 11 of the 2012 Act; and
 - (b) the revoked provisions continue to have effect for the purposes of that section.
