**The Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Air Pollution  
from Ships) (Amendment) Regulations 2023**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by articles 2 and 3(a), (b)(ii), (c) and (e) of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Air Pollution from Ships) Order 2006<sup>(1)</sup>, articles 2(2)(a) and (f) and (3)(b) of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Law of the Sea Convention) Order 1996<sup>(2)</sup> and sections 128(5) and (6), 302 and 306A of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995<sup>(3)</sup>, makes the following Regulations.
