**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Old Buckenham)
Regulations 2023**

Made - - - - *12th May 2023*

Coming into force - - *29th July 2023*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the area specified in regulation 3(1) by reason of the intended holding there of flying displays associated with the Old Buckenham Air Show.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Old Buckenham) Regulations 2023 and they come into force on 29th July 2023.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time^(b).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1100 hours and 1800 hours on each of the two days beginning on 29th July 2023 and ending on 30th July 2023 no aircraft is to fly below 5,000 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by—

- (a) straight lines joining successively the following points—
 - (i) 522718N 0010805E, and
 - (ii) 522451N 0010330E,
- (b) the clockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 5 nautical miles centred at 522949N 0010305E between 522451N 0010330E and 523034N 0005454E,
- (c) straight lines joining successively the following points—
 - (i) 523034N 0005454E, and
 - (ii) 523259N 0005906E, and
- (d) the clockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 4 nautical miles centred at 522949N 0010305E between 523259N 0005906E and 522718N 0010805E.

^(b) Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with a permission issued by the Old Buckenham Air Show flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in the vicinity of Old Buckenham, Norfolk during air displays that are scheduled to take place there on 29th July 2023 and 30th July 2023.

Many aircraft will be involved in high energy manoeuvres during the displays and therefore the Civil Aviation Authority and the Department for Transport agree that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the event for reasons of public safety.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2), the Old Buckenham Air Show flying display director may be contacted as notified.

Full details of this Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC) and Notice to Aviation (NOTAM).
