Further provision in relation to investigations under regulation 36 (investigations by the Commissioner)

PART 1

Modifications

Application of ^{F1}the Armed Forces (Disposal of Property) Regulations 2023]

6.—(1) ^{F2}The Armed Forces (Disposal of Property) Regulations 2023] apply in relation to such investigations with the following modifications.

^{F3}(2) Regulation 2 of those Regulations is to be read as if the definition of “service police” was omitted.]

(3) Any reference in those Regulations to—

- (a) a service policeman, is to be read as a reference to a person designated under regulation 36(2) of these Regulations;
- (b) the service police is to be read as a reference to the Service Police Complaints Commissioner.
