# The Divorce, Dissolution and Separation Act 2020 (Consequential Amendments) Regulations 2023

Made - - - - - 4th July 2023

Laid before Parliament 6th July 2023

Coming into force - - 1st August 2023

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred by section 6(2) of the Divorce, Dissolution and Separation Act 2020(a), makes the following Regulations.

### Citation, commencement and extent

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Divorce, Dissolution and Separation Act 2020 (Consequential Amendments) Regulations 2023 and come into force on 1st August 2023.
  - (2) These Regulations extend to England and Wales.

### Amendment to the Registration of Marriage Regulations 2015

- **2.** In Schedule 3 (evidence) to the Registration of Marriage Regulations 2015(**b**), in paragraph 5(1)(a)—
  - (a) after "decree absolute" insert "or final order";
  - (b) after "marriage" insert "or nullity of marriage order".
