Provisions coming into force

 - (iii) the Scotland Act 1998 (Cross-Border Public Authorities) (Adaptation of Functions etc.) Order 1999(3);
 - (iv) the Scotland Act 1998 (Consequential Modifications) (No. 2) Order 1999(4);
 - (v) the Freedom of Information Act 2000(5);
 - (vi) the Police, Public Order and Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 2006(6);
 - (vii) paragraph 38 of Schedule 16 to the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011(7);
 - (viii) the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012(8);
 - (ix) the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012 (Consequential Provisions and Modifications) Order 2013(9).
