Transitional Provisions

**Marriage: Registrar General's licence**

6. Where—

- (a) a Registrar General's licence has been issued under section 7 of the 1970 Act before the relevant date;
- (b) the marriage has not been solemnized before the relevant date; and
- (c) either or both parties to the proposed marriage are under the age of 18 years on the relevant date and will remain under the age of 18 for the entirety of the period of validity of the licence as determined by section 8(1) of the 1970 Act,

the notices of marriage and the licence are void and no person may solemnize the marriage on the authority of that licence.
