The Minister of Pensions hereby makes the following Rules:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the War Pensions (Payment in Advance) Rules, 1920.
- 2. Any payment being administered by or under the authority of the Minister of Pensions, other than annuities for meritorious service or Victoria Cross pensions, may be issued in advance for a period not exceeding six months (in addition to the pension for the current period of payment) subject to the following conditions:—
 - (1) That the pensioner is about to emigrate to any British Possession out of the United Kingdom; or
 - (2) That the pensioner is about to be repatriated, after service in His Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces, to any British Possession out of the United Kingdom or elsewhere.
