The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury by virtue of the power conferred on them by subsection (2) of section 10 of the Government Annuities Act, 1929, hereby prescribe the persons specified in the Schedule to this Order as the persons by whom certificates of the existence of nominees required for the purposes of the said Section 10 may be given.

## SCHEDULE

(i) In the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man.

A Minister of Religion habitually officiating at a place of Worship within 10 miles of the place where the Nominee resides for the time being. (The denomination and the address of the place of Worship to be stated.)

A Justice of the Peace.

A Barrister-at-Law, a Commissioner of Oaths, a duly qualified Solicitor, or (in Scotland) an Advocate.

A Notary Public.

A Person registered under the Medical Act and regularly practising within 10 miles of the place where the Nominee resides for the time being.

A Banker, or the Agent or Manager of a Bank, who must impress his official stamp after signature.

The Actuary or Principal Officer of a Trustee Savings Bank certified under the Act of 1863.

A Postmaster, or Postmistress or other Officer actually in charge of any Head, Branch or Sub Post Office who must impress his Office stamp after signature.

An Officer or Retired Officer of any of His Majesty's Naval, Military, or Air Forces who must state his rank.

A Person who is on the active or pension list of the Permanent Civil Service of the Crown who is, or was at the date of retirement, in receipt of a salary of not less than £200 a year and on a scale rising to not less than £300 a year.

(ii) In the Dominion of Canada, the Commonwealth of Australia (including the Mandated Territory of New Guinea), the Dominion of New Zealand (including the Mandated Territory of Western Samoa), the Union of South Africa (including the Mandated Territory of South West Africa), Newfoundland and Southern Rhodesia.

A Justice of the Peace.

A Government Police Magistrate.

The Agent or Manager of a Bank registered under the law of the Dominion or Colony who must impress his Office stamp after signature.

The Agent or Manager of the local Branch of a Joint Stock Bank having its head office in London, who must impress his Office stamp after signature.

A Barrister-at-Law, or a Solicitor.

A Physician or Surgeon registered as such under the Medical Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom or under the law of the Dominion or Colony and regularly practising within 10 miles of the place where the Nominee resides for the time being.

An Officer or Retired Officer of any of His Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces who must state his rank.

## (iii) In the Irish Free State.

A Peace Commissioner.

A District Justice.

The Agent, or Manager of a Bank who must impress his Office stamp after signature.

A Physician or Surgeon registered as such and regularly practising within 10 miles of the place where the Nominee resides for the time being.

An Officer or Retired Officer of any of His Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces who must state his rank.

A Barrister.

A Solicitor.

(iv) In India.

A District Magistrate.

(In Presidency Towns) A Commissioner of Police.

(v) In His Majesty's dominions (other than the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, the Dominion of Canada, the Commonwealth of Australia, the Dominion of New Zealand, the Union of South Africa, the Irish Free State, Newfoundland, Southern Rhodesia, and India) and any territories which are under His Majesty's protection or in respect of which a mandate on behalf of the League of Nations has been accepted by His Majesty and is exercised by His Government in the United Kingdom.

A Justice of the Peace.

A Government Police Magistrate.

The Agent or Manager of a Bank registered under the law of the territory who must impress his Office stamp after signature.

The Agent or Manager of the local Branch of a Joint Stock Bank having its head office in London, who must impress his Office stamp after signature.

A Barrister-at-Law or a Solicitor.

A Physician or Surgeon registered as such under the Medical Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom or under the law of the territory and regularly practising within 10 miles of the place where the Nominee resides for the time being.

An Officer or Retired Officer of any of His Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces who must state his rank.

A Person holding a pensionable appointment in the service of the Crown (or the Civil Service of the Mandated Territory, as the case may be) in receipt of a salary of not less than £300 a year.

(vi) In any other Territories.

One of His Majesty's Diplomatic or Consular Officers empowered by law to administer Oaths.

A Physician or Surgeon registered as such under the Medical Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom or under the law of the territory and regularly practising within 10 miles of the place where the Nominee is residing for the time being.

A Minister of Religion duly licensed by Ecclesiastical authority in the United Kingdom to officiate as Chaplain in the place where he attests.

The Chief Magistrate of the City, Town or Place where the Nominee shall be residing, or any other Magistrate acting at the same time as such, or for, or in the place of any such Magistrate, if one of His Majesty's Diplomatic or Consular Officers or Person acting as such, shall not be resident in such City, Town or Place (to be so stated).

The Agent or Manager of the local Branch of a Joint Stock Bank having its Head Office in London, who must impress his Office stamp after signature.

An Officer or Retired Officer of any of His Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces who must state his rank.
