(5) Prescription of Interest

THE LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930 (PRESCRIPTION OF INTEREST) REGULATIONS, 1932, DATED APRIL 8, 1932, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT.

1932 No. 306

Whereas by Section 42 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, (hereinafter 20 & 21 Geo. referred to as "the Act"), it is enacted that where any navigable 5. c. 44. waters within a drainage district are not subject to the control of any navigation authority, harbour authority or conservancy authority, the drainage board of that district may apply to the Minister of Transport (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") for an Order imposing tolls in respect of the navigation of vessels in those waters ;

And whereas under or by virtue of the said Section and of Part II of the Second Schedule to the Act, it is enacted that a memorial may be presented to the Minister by any person affected by such Order and having such interest as may be prescribed by regulations made by the Minister as being sufficient for the purpose, praying that such Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon him under or by virtue of the Act, and of all other powers him thereunto enabling. the Minister hereby makes the following Regulations :---

1. In any case in which the Minister shall have made an Order under Section 42 of the Act, the following persons shall be deemed to have sufficient interest for the purpose of presenting such Memorial as aforesaid :--

- (a) The Drainage Board upon whose application the said Order shall have been made.
- (b) Any person using the navigable waters in respect of which the said Order shall have been made and who shall be affected by the imposition of the tolls imposed thereby, or any Association of Traders or Freighters or Chambers of Commerce, Shipping or Agriculture representing the interests of that person.
- (c) Any harbour authority, conservancy authority or navigation authority whose harbour, conservancy or navigation may be reached by the said navigable waters.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies for the purpose of the 52 & 53 Vict. interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the c. 63. interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. These Regulations may be cited as "The Land Drainage Act, 1930 (Prescription of Interest) Regulations, 1932."
