In exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Agricultural Produce 18 & 19 Geo. (Grading and Marking) Acts, 1928 and 1931, the Minister of Agriculture 5. c. 19. and Fisheries hereby makes the following Regulations:— 21 & 22 Geo. and Fisheries hereby makes the following Regulations:-

5. c. 40.

1. A grade designation to indicate the quality of Leicester cheese Prescription made from cows' milk produced in England and Wales shall be as of grade follows:-

and the quality indicated by such grade designation shall be deemed to be the quality as described in the First Schedule hereto.

The grade designation mark shall be the grade designation specified Prescription in regulation 1 above associated with the words "Empire Buying Begins of grade at Home," and with the following mark, namely, a map of England and designation Wales in silhouette with the words "Produce of England and Wales" mark. inscribed in a circle placed centrally in the map within which circle is a design representing the Union Jack, and which is more particularly described in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. "In any certificate issued by the National Mark Committee under Construction the Agricultural Produce (Grading and Marking) (General) Regulations, of certificates 1928,(a) authorizing the marking of Leicester cheese with the grade of authorizadesignation mark prescribed by the Regulations hereby revoked, references to the said Regulations shall be construed as references to these Regulations.

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 20th October, Date of 1937, on which date the Agricultural Produce (Grading and Marking) coming into (Leicester Cheese) Regulations, 1936, (b) shall be revoked, but without operation prejudice to anything done thereunder before the date of coming into and revocaoperation of these Regulations.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce Short title. (Grading and Marking) (Leicester Cheese) Regulations, 1937.

SCHEDULE I

LEICESTER CHEESE MADE FROM COWS' MILK PRODUCED IN ENGLAND AND WALES: DEFINITION OF QUALITY OF SELECTED GRADE

General Requirements		The cheese shall be a hard-pressed cheese made from full-cream cows' milk, and shall contain a minimum of 45 per cent. of butter fat in the moisture-free substance.
Special Requirements	Colour	The cheese shall be deeply and uniformly coloured.
	Finish and Appearance	Rind intact, smooth and thin.
	Weight	Not less than 16 lbs.
	Shape	Cylindrical, the diameter to be approximately 3½ times the depth.
	Texture and Body	lexture moderately open and short. Body moderately firm and mellow. Free from gas holes.
	Flavour	Full and clean. Free from taints and sourness.
	Minimum Age at Time of Grading	4 weeks.
