In exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Agricultural Produce 18 & 19 Geo. (Grading and Marking) Acts, 1928 and 1931, the Minister of Agriculture 5. c. 19. 21 & 22 Geo. and Fisheries hereby makes the following Regulations :---5. c. 40.

1. A grade designation to indicate the quality of cream cheese made Prescription from cream obtained from cows' milk produced in England and Wales of Grade Designation. shall be as follows :---

EXTRA SELECTED (DOUBLE CREAM)

and the quality indicated by such grade designation shall be deemed to be the quality as described in the First Schedule hereto.

The grade designation mark shall be the grade designation specified Prescription 2. in regulation 1 above associated with the words "Empire Buying Begins of Grade at Home," and with the following mark, namely, a map of England and Designation Wales in silhouette with the words "Produce of England and Wales" Mark. inscribed in a circle placed centrally in the map within which circle is a design representing the Union Jack, and which is more particularly described in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. In any certificate issued by the National Mark Committee under Construction the Agricultural Produce (Grading and Marking) (General) Regulations, of certificates 1928, (a) authorizing the marking of cream cheese with the grade designa- of authorisation mark prescribed by the Regulations hereby revoked, references to tion. the said Regulations shall be construed as references to these Regulations.

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 27th May, Date of 1938, on which date the Agricultural Produce (Grading and Marking) coming into (Cream Cheese) Regulations, 1935,(b) shall be revoked, but without operation prejudice to anything done thereunder before the date of coming into and revocation. operation of these Regulations.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce Short title. (Grading and Marking) (Cream Cheese) Regulations, 1938.
