## The Conduct of Members (Principles) (Wales) Order 2001

### Interpretation

#### 2. In this Order—

“co-opted member” (“*aelod cyfetholedig*”), in relation to a relevant authority, means a person who is not a member of the authority but who—

- (a) is a member of any committee or sub-committee of the authority, or
- (b) is a member of, and represents the authority on, any joint committee or joint sub-committee of the authority,

and who is entitled to vote on any question which falls to be decided at any meeting of that committee or sub-committee;

“member” (“*aelod*”) includes a co-opted member; and

“relevant authority” (“*awdurdod perthnasol*”) means—

- (a) a county council,
- (b) a county borough council,
- (c) a community council,
- (ca) [<sup>F1</sup>a corporate joint committee established by regulations made under Part 5 of the Local Government and Elections (Wales) Act 2021 (asc 1),]
- (d) [<sup>F2</sup>a fire and rescue authority constituted by a scheme under section 2 of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004 or a scheme to which section 4 of that Act applies, and]
- (e) a National Park authority established under section 63 of the Environment Act 1995<sup>(1)</sup>.
