The Ceredigion and Pembrokeshire (St Dogmaels) Order 2002

Made - - - - 6th December 2002

Coming into force in accordance with Article 1(2)

The Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales has submitted to the National Assembly for Wales in accordance with sections 54(1) and 58(1) of the Local Government Act 1972⁽¹⁾ a report dated December 2001 on its review of part of the boundary between the Counties of Ceredigion and Pembrokeshire in the area of the community of St Dogmaels together with the proposals they have formulated thereon;

and the National Assembly for Wales having decided to give effect to these proposals with modifications the effect of which includes the transfer an area of land adjoining the property of “Parc Y Ffrier” from the County of Ceredigion to the County of Pembrokeshire;

and more than six weeks having elapsed since those proposals were made;

now the National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers given to the Secretary of State by section 58(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 which are vested in the National Assembly for Wales so far as exercisable in Wales⁽²⁾ makes the following Order:—
