**The National Health Service (Pharmaceutical Services)
(Amendment) (No.2) (Wales) Regulations 2003**

Made - - - - - *9th December 2003*

Coming into force - - - - - *12th December 2003*

The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 41, 42, 43 and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977⁽¹⁾ hereby makes the following Regulations:
