SCHEDULE 1

MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

Medicines (Pharmacy and General Sale – Exemption) Order 1980

2.—(1) The Medicines (Pharmacy and General Sale – Exemption) Order 1980(1) shall be amended as provided in this paragraph.

(2) In article 4B (exemption for health professionals who supply medicinal products under a Patient Group Direction in order to assist doctors or dentists in providing national health services)(2)—

(a) in paragraph (2)(d) (ii)—

- (i) after "health authority" insert "or Local Health Board",
- (ii) before sub-paragraph (a), insert-
 - "(aa) in the case of the provision of primary medical services, with which a contract or agreement for the provision of those services has been made or which provides the services itself,", and

(iii) in sub-paragraph (a), omit "general medical services", and

and

- (b) in paragraph (3), for sub-paragraph (b)(i) substitute—
 - "(i) in relation to England and Wales, the provision of primary medical services under Part I of the National Health Service Act 1977;".
