1. Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio Rheoliadau Fformwla Fabanod a Fformwla Ddilynol 1995, fel y'u diwygiwyd ("Rheoliadau 1995"), mewn perthynas â Chymru. Mae Rheoliadau 1995 yn gymwys i Brydain Fawr. Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn gweithredu ar gyfer Cymru Gyfarwyddeb y Comisiwn 2003/14/EC (OJ Rhif 41, 14.2.2003, t.37) sy'n diwygio Cyfarwyddeb 91/321/EEC (OJ Rhif L175, 4.7.91, t.35) ar fformwlâu babanod a fformwlâu dilynol. Mae'r Rheoliadau yn dod i rym ar 6 Mawrth 2005.

2. Er mwyn gweithredu Cyfarwyddeb 2003/14/EC mae'r Rheoliadau -

(a) yn gwahardd gwerthu, neu allforio i drydydd gwledydd, fformwlâu babanod neu fformwlâu dilynol sy'n cynnwys gweddillion plateiddiaid uwchlaw lefelau penodol. Mae lefelau gwahanol wedi'u pennu yn dibynnau ar y plateiddiad o dan sylw (rheoliadau 4, 5, 7 a 10 a'r Atodlen); a

(b) yn gwneud rhai diwygiadau canlyniadol (rheoliadau 3 a 6).

3. Er mwyn gweithredu brawddeg olaf Erthygl 6(2) o Gyfarwyddeb 91/321/EEC fel y'i hamnewidiwyd gan Gyfarwyddeb y Comisiwn 1999/50/EC, mae darpariaeth yn cael ei gwneud ynglŷn â dulliau dadansoddiadol ar gyfer penderfynu lefelau gweddillion plateiddiaid (rheoliad 7).

4. Mae'r Rheoliadau hefyd -

The Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2004

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

1. These Regulations amend the Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula Regulations 1995, as amended ("the 1995 Regulations"), in relation to Wales. The 1995 Regulations extend to Great Britain. These Regulations implement for Wales Commission Directive 2003/14/EC (OJ No.L41, 14.2.2003, p.37) amending Directive 91/321/EEC (OJ No.L175, 4.7.91, p.35) on infant formulae and follow-on formulae. The Regulations come into force on 6th March 2005.

2. In implementation of Directive 2003/14/EC the Regulations -

(a) prohibit the sale, or export to third countries, of infant formulae or follow-on formulae containing pesticide residues above certain levels. Different levels are set depending on the pesticide in question (regulations 4, 5, 7 and 10 and Schedule); and

(b) make some consequential amendments (regulations 3 and 6).

3. In implementation of the final sentence of Article 6(2) of Directive 91/321/EEC as substituted by Commission Directive 1999/50/EC, provision is made as to analytical methods for determining levels of pesticide residues (regulation 7).

4. The Regulations also -

(a) give port health authorities a role in

- (b) make some technical changes to the provision applying various provisions of the Food Safety Act 1990 (regulation 9).

The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6(4), 16(1)(a) and (f), 17(1), 26(1) and (3) and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990(a) and now vested in it(b), having had regard in accordance with section 48(4A) of that Act to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency and after consultation both as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council(c) laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety and in accordance with section 48(4) and (4B) of that Act, makes the following Regulations:

Title, application and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2004; they apply in relation to Wales only and come into force on 6th March 2005.

Amendment of the Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula Regulations 1995

2. The Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula Regulations 1995(d) shall be amended (in so far as they apply in relation to Wales) in accordance with regulations 3 to 10.

(b) Functions formerly exercisable by "the Secretary of State" so far as exercisable in relation to Wales were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672), as read with section 40(3) of the Food Standards Act 1999 (1999 c.28).

3. Yn rheoliad 1(2) (dehongli), yn y diffiniad o "the Directive", yn lle'r geiriau "Commission Directive 1999/50/EC" rhowch y geiriau "Commission Directive 2003/14/EC(a)".

4. Yn rheoliadau 2(ii) a 3(b) (amodau ar gyfer gwerthu fformwlâu babanod a fformwlâu dilynol), yn lle'r ymadrodd "regulation 12" rhowch yr ymadrodd "regulations 12 and 12A".

5. Yn rheoliadau 5(1)(a) a 6(1)(a) (allforio fformwlâu babanod a fformwlâu dilynol i drydydd gwledydd), yn lle'r ymadrodd "11 and 12" rhowch yr ymadrodd ", 11, 12 and 12A".

6. Yn rheoliadau 8(2) a 9(2) (cyfansoddiad fformwlâu babanod a fformwlâu dilynol), hepgorwch y geiriau o "and it shall not" hyd at y diwedd.

7. Ar ôl rheoliad 12 (cyfansoddiad fformwlâu babanod a fformwlâu dilynol) mewnosodwch y rheoliad canlynol -

"12A.-(1) No infant formula or follow-on formula shall contain -

- (a) any pesticide residue of a pesticide specified in Schedule 7A; or
- (b) any omethoate, where it is a metabolite of a pesticide not specified in Schedule 7A, or any product resulting from degradation or reaction of that metabolite,

at a level exceeding 0.003 mg/kg.

(2) No infant formula or follow-on formula shall contain any pesticide residue of a pesticide specified in column 1 of Schedule 7B at a level exceeding that specified in column 2 of that Schedule in relation to that pesticide.

(3) No infant formula or follow-on formula shall contain any pesticide residue of any individual pesticide which is not specified in Schedule 7A or column 1 of Schedule 7B at a level exceeding 0.01 mg/kg.

(4) The levels referred to in paragraphs (1) to (3) apply to the infant formula or follow-on formula -

- (a) manufactured as ready for consumption, or
- (b) if it is not so manufactured, as reconstituted according to its manufacturer's instructions.

(5) Analytical methods for determining levels of pesticide residues for the purposes of this regulation shall be generally acceptable standardised methods.".

3. In regulation 1(2) (interpretation), in the definition of "the Directive", for the words "Commission Directive 1999/50/EC" there shall be substituted the words "Commission Directive 2003/14/EC(a)".

4. In regulations 2(ii) and 3(b) (conditions for the sale of infant formulae and follow-on formulae), for the expression "regulation 12" there shall be substituted the expression "regulations 12 and 12A".

5. In regulations 5(1)(a) and 6(1)(a) (export of infant formulae and follow-on formulae to third countries), for the expression "11 and 12" there shall be substituted the expression ", 11, 12 and 12A".

6. In regulations 8(2) and 9(2) (composition of infant formulae and follow-on formulae), the words from "and it shall not" to the end shall be omitted.

7. After regulation 12 (composition of infant formulae and follow-on formulae) there shall be inserted the following regulation -

"12A.-(1) No infant formula or follow-on formula shall contain -

- (a) any pesticide residue of a pesticide specified in Schedule 7A; or
- (b) any omethoate, where it is a metabolite of a pesticide not specified in Schedule 7A, or any product resulting from degradation or reaction of that metabolite,

at a level exceeding 0.003 mg/kg.

(2) No infant formula or follow-on formula shall contain any pesticide residue of a pesticide specified in column 1 of Schedule 7B at a level exceeding that specified in column 2 of that Schedule in relation to that pesticide.

(3) No infant formula or follow-on formula shall contain any pesticide residue of any individual pesticide which is not specified in Schedule 7A or column 1 of Schedule 7B at a level exceeding 0.01 mg/kg.

(4) The levels referred to in paragraphs (1) to (3) apply to the infant formula or follow-on formula -

- (a) manufactured as ready for consumption, or
- (b) if it is not so manufactured, as reconstituted according to its manufacturer's instructions.

(5) Analytical methods for determining levels of pesticide residues for the purposes of this regulation shall be generally acceptable standardised methods.".

8. In regulation 22 (offences and enforcement) -

(a) in paragraph (2) there shall be inserted at the beginning the words "Except where paragraph (2A) below applies,";

(b) after paragraph (2) there shall be inserted the

- (b) section 3 (presumptions that food is intended for human consumption);
- (c) section 20 (offences due to fault of another person);
- (d) section 21 (defence of due diligence) as it applies for the purposes of section 8, 14 or 15;
- (e) section 30(8) (which relates to documentary evidence);
- (f) section 33(1) (obstruction etc. of officers);
- (g) section 33(2), with the modification that the reference to "any such requirement as is mentioned in subsection (1)(b) above" shall be deemed to be a reference to any such requirement as is mentioned in that subsection as applied by paragraph (f) above;
- (h) section 35(1) (punishment of offences) in so far as it relates to offences under section 33(1) as applied by paragraph (f) above;
- (i) section 35(2) and (3) in so far as it relates to offences under section 33(2) as applied by paragraph (g) above;
- (j) section 36 (offences by bodies corporate); and
- (k) section 44 (protection of officers acting in good faith).".

- (g) section 33(2), with the modification that the reference to "any such requirement as is mentioned in subsection (1)(b) above" shall be deemed to be a reference to any such requirement as is mentioned in that subsection as applied by paragraph (f) above;
- (h) section 35(1) (punishment of offences) in so far as it relates to offences under section 33(1) as applied by paragraph (f) above;
- (i) section 35(2) and (3) in so far as it relates to offences under section 33(2) as applied by paragraph (g) above;
- (j) section 36 (offences by bodies corporate); and
- (k) section 44 (protection of officers acting in good faith).".

10. After Schedule 7 (the mineral elements in cows' milk) there shall be inserted as Schedules 7A and 7B the contents of the Schedule to these Regulations.
