**The Fire and Rescue Services (Charging) (Wales) Order 2006**

**Title, commencement, application and interpretation**

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Fire and Rescue Services (Charging) (Wales) Order 2006 and it comes into force on 13 July 2006.

(2) This Order applies in relation to fire and rescue authorities in Wales.

(3) In this Order—

“the Act” (“*y Ddeddf*”) means the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004;

“operator” (“*gweithredydd*”) means the person who, as occupier or otherwise, has control of the premises, structure, lift or vehicle, as the case may be, in connection with the carrying on by that person of a trade, business or other undertaking (whether or not for profit) and includes the keeper of a vehicle as defined in section 62(2) of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994<sup>(1)</sup>; and

“premises” (“*mangre*”) includes any place.
