The Private Dentistry (Wales) Regulations 2008

The Welsh Ministers, having consulted such persons as they consider appropriate⁽¹⁾, make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 12(2), 14(1)(d), 15(3), 16(1), 16(3) 22(1), 22(2)(a), (c) and (d), 25(1), 42(1) and 118(5) to (7) of the Care Standards Act 2000⁽²⁾.

(2) [2000 c. 14](#). The powers are conferred upon the “appropriate Minister”. “Appropriate Minister” means the Assembly in relation to Wales: see section 121(1) of the Act. The powers are transferred to the Welsh Ministers by paragraph 30 of schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 ([c. 32](#)). Section 42(1) of the Act provides that regulations may apply the provisions of Part II of the Act to persons prescribed by those regulations. By virtue of regulation 3 (made under s.42(1) of, and Schedule 1 to, these Regulations, the persons prescribed in regulation 3(1) are made subject to the relevant provisions of Part II of the Act.
