**EDUCATION, WALES**

**The School Information (Wales) Regulations 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *29 July 2011*  
*Laid before the National*  
*Assembly for Wales* - - - *4 August 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - - *1 September 2011*

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 29(5), 408, 537(1) to (8) and 569(4) and (5) of, and paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to, the Education Act 1996<sup>(1)</sup> and sections 92 and 138(7) and (8) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998<sup>(2)</sup>, and now vested in them<sup>(3)</sup>, and after consulting with those persons with whom consultation appeared to them to be desirable, make the following Regulations:

- (3) The functions of the Secretary of State in sections 29(5), 408, 537(1) to (8) and 569(4) and (5) of the Education Act 1996 and the power to make regulations in respect of Wales in section 138 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672) and then to the Welsh Ministers by paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32).
