ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A470 Trunk Road (Commings Coch, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011

Made 21 November 2011

Coming into force 3 December 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Caersws to Machynlleth Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and of all other enabling powers ⁽²⁾ make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 3 December 2011 and its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Commings Coch, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011 .

2. (1) In this Order :

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the trunk road at Commings Coch, in the County of Powys, which extends from the centre-point of its junction with the C2083 (Capel Ty Cerrig), to the centre-point of its junction with the C2082 (The Terrace);

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 18.00 hours on 3 December 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 6 months.
