The Healthy Start Scheme (Description of Healthy Start Food) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2011

The Welsh Ministers make the following Regulations, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(1) and (6) of the Social Security Act 1988⁽¹⁾.

Title, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Healthy Start Scheme (Description of Healthy Start Food) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 and they come into force on 6 April 2011.

(2) In these Regulations “the principal Regulations” (“*y prif Reoliadau*”) means the Healthy Start Scheme (Description of Healthy Start Food) (Wales) Regulations 2006⁽²⁾.

Amendment to the Schedule of the principal Regulations

2. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended as follows—

(1) In column 1 (Category of food) of the table, in the third category insert “or frozen” after the word “Fresh”; and

(2) In column 2 (Qualification) of the table, substitute the third qualification with the following—
“Fresh or frozen fruit and vegetables including but not limited to loose, pre-packed, whole, sliced, chopped, or mixed fruit or vegetables, but not fruit or vegetables to which fat, salt, sugar, flavouring or any other ingredients have been added.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Healthy Start Scheme (Description of Healthy Start Food) (Wales) Regulations 2006 (“the principal Regulations”).

Regulation 2 amends the Schedule to the principal Regulations, by revising the definition of fruit and vegetables to include “frozen” fruit and vegetables and to make the qualification of that category clearer.
