**The A4076 Trunk Road (Milford
Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary
Traffic Restriction & Prohibitions)
Order 2012**

Made 27 December 2012

Coming into force 7 January 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Haverfordwest – Milford Haven Trunk Road (A4076) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”) are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 7 January 2013 and its title is The A4076 Trunk Road (Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Restriction & Prohibitions) Order 2012.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (*“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”*) means the lengths of the A4076 trunk road at Milford Haven in the County of Pembrokeshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 7 January 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Restriction & Prohibitions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 whilst the provisions of article 4 are in force.

Application

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only at such times and to such extent as traffic signs indicate the restriction or prohibitions referred to therein.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 5 metres south of its junction with Charles Street, southbound along Great North Road and westbound along Hamilton Terrace, to a point 5 metres east of its junction with Dartmouth Street.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit and No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 5 metres south of its junction with Phillips Avenue, south-westbound along Steynton Road, Castle Terrace and Great North Road and westbound along Hamilton Terrace and Victoria Road, to the end of the splitter island west of Victoria Street roundabout.
