**The National Curriculum (Educational Programmes
for the Foundation Phase and Programmes of Study for
the Second and Third Key Stages) (Wales) Order 2013**

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on the National Assembly for Wales by section 108(2)(b)(iii), (3)(b) and (5) and section 210 of the Education Act 2002⁽¹⁾ and now vested in them⁽²⁾ and having made such arrangements for consultation as they consider appropriate in accordance with section 117 of the Education Act 2002⁽³⁾ make the following Order:

Title, commencement and application

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the National Curriculum (Educational Programmes for the Foundation Phase and Programmes of Study for the Second and Third Key Stages) (Wales) Order 2013 and it comes into force on 1 September 2013.

(2) This Order applies in relation to Wales.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this Order—

“the “ar drywydd llythrennedd” document” (“*y ddogfen ar drywydd llythrennedd*”) means the document published by the Welsh Ministers in January 2013 entitled “Ar drywydd llythrennedd”⁽⁴⁾;

PART 1

Foundation Phase

Literacy — oracy

3.—(1) The provisions set out in that part of the llythrennedd — llafaredd document entitled “Y Cyfnod Sylfaen” have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning for Welsh-speaking schools.

(2) For all other schools the provisions set out in that part of the literacy — oracy document entitled “Foundation Phase” have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning.

Literacy — reading

4.—(1) The provisions set out in that part of the llythrennedd — darllen document entitled “Y Cyfnod Sylfaen” have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning for Welsh-speaking schools.

(2) For all other schools the provisions set out in that part of the literacy — reading document entitled “Foundation Phase” have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning.

Literacy — writing

5.—(1) The provisions set out in that part of the llythrennedd — ysgrifennu document entitled “Y Cyfnod Sylfaen” have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning for Welsh-speaking schools.

(2) For all other schools the provisions set out in that part of the literacy — writing document entitled “Foundation Phase” have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning.

Numeracy

6. The provisions set out in that part of the numeracy document entitled “Foundation Phase” have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning for all schools.

Routes to literacy

7.—(1) The provisions set out in the ar drywydd llythrennedd document have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning for Welsh-speaking schools.

(2) For all other schools the provisions set out in the routes to literacy document have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning.

Routes to numeracy

8. The provisions set out in the routes to numeracy document have effect for the purpose of specifying educational programmes in relation to the relevant areas of learning for all schools.

PART 2

Second and Third Key Stages

Literacy — oracy

9.—(1) The provisions set out in those parts of the literacy — oracy document entitled “Key Stage 2” and “Key Stage 3” have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for all schools.

(2) The provisions set out in those parts of the llythrennedd — llafaredd document entitled “Cyfnod Allweddol 2” and “Cyfnod Allweddol 3” have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for Welsh-speaking schools.

Literacy — reading

10.—(1) The provisions set out in those parts of the literacy — reading document entitled “Key Stage 2” and “Key Stage 3” have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for all schools.

(2) The provisions set out in those parts of the llythrennedd — darllen document entitled “Cyfnod Allweddol 2” and “Cyfnod Allweddol 3” have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for Welsh-speaking schools.

Literacy — writing

11.—(1) The provisions set out in those parts of the literacy — writing document entitled “Key Stage 2” and “Key Stage 3” have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for all schools.

(2) The provisions set out in those parts of the llythrennedd — ysgrifennu document entitled “Cyfnod Allweddol 2” and “Cyfnod Allweddol 3” have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for Welsh-speaking schools.

Numeracy

12. The provisions set out in those parts of the numeracy document entitled “Key Stage 2” and “Key Stage 3” have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for all schools.

Routes to literacy

13.—(1) The provisions set out in the ar drywydd llythrennedd document have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for Welsh-speaking schools.

(2) For all other schools the provisions set out in the routes to literacy document have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects.

Routes to numeracy

14. The provisions set out in the routes to numeracy document have effect for the purpose of specifying programmes of study in relation to the relevant subjects for all schools.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Section 108(2)(b)(iii) and (3) of the Education Act 2002 provides a power for the Welsh Ministers to prescribe by way of an Order educational programmes in respect of the foundation phase and programmes of study in respect of the key stages. The educational programmes and programmes of study set out what pupils must be taught.

The current educational programmes for the areas of learning in the foundation phase were given legal effect by the Education (National Curriculum) (Foundation Stage) (Wales) Order 2008. The current programmes of study for the subjects in the second, third and fourth key stages were given legal effect by the Education (National Curriculum) (Attainment Targets and Programmes of Study) (Wales) Order 2008.

This Order gives legal effect to additional educational programmes for the language, literacy and communication skills and mathematical development areas of learning in the foundation phase (Part 1 of the Order).

This Order also gives legal effect to the additional programmes of study in English, Welsh and mathematics in the second and third key stages (Part 2 of the Order).
