**The A40 Trunk Road (Park Road,  
Abergavenny, Monmouthshire)  
(Temporary Closure of Footway)  
Order 2015**

*Made* *12 November 2015*

*Coming into force* *16 November 2015*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Raglan - Llandovery Trunk Road (A40) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that the specified length of the trunk road should be closed by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon or near to.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 16 November 2015. Its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Park Road, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Closure of Footway) Order 2015.

**2.** —1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the footway on the southern side of the A40 trunk road known as Park Road, Abergavenny in the County of Monmouthshire that extends from a point 23 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Hereford Road in a westerly direction to a point 7 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with Priory Lane.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 16 November 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

**Prohibition**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4 no person, shall, during the works period, proceed along the length of the footway.

**Application**

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

**Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
