#### **Non-Contentious Probate Fees Order 2004**

**189.** In paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 1A (remissions and part remissions) to the Non-Contentious Probate Fees Order 2004<sup>(1)</sup>, in paragraph (c) of the definition of “excluded benefits”—

- (a) omit “the Community Care, Services for Carers and Children’s Services (Direct Payments) (Wales) Regulations 2011”;
- (b) after “2002” omit “or”;
- (c) after “1968” insert “or under regulations made under sections 50 to 53 of the Social Services and Well-being (Wales) Act 2014”.
