[^{F1}Transitional arrangements

[^{F27} Food for special medical purposes that does not comply with any specified provision of the Delegated Regulation specified in Schedule 1 may continue to be marketed until stocks of such food are exhausted provided that—

- (a) it complies with the provisions of the EU Regulation specified in Schedule 1,
- (b) it was placed on the market or labelled—
 - (i) before 22 February 2019, or
 - (ii) before 22 February 2020 in the case of food for special medical purposes developed to satisfy the nutritional requirements of infants, and
- (c) the requirements specified in regulation 3(1) and (2) of the Medical Food (Wales) Regulations 2000 are met.]]
