**The Education Workforce Council (Membership and Appointment) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2018**

**Title and commencement**

1.—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Education Workforce Council (Membership and Appointment) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2018.

(2) These Regulations come into force on 9 August 2018.

**Amendment**

2. Schedule 2 to the Education Workforce Council (Membership and Appointment) (Wales) Regulations 2014<sup>(1)</sup> is amended as follows—

(a) in Part 1—

(i) for paragraph 1 substitute—

“1. National Education Union.”; and

(ii) omit paragraph 7; and

(b) in Part 2, after paragraph 27 insert—

“28. Council for Wales of Voluntary Youth Services Cyngor Cymreig y Gwasanaethau Ieuenctid Gwirfoddol<sup>(2)</sup>.

29. Wales Principal Youth Officers’ Group<sup>(3)</sup>.

30. National Training Federation for Wales Ltd<sup>(4)</sup>.

31. Education Training Standards Wales<sup>(5)</sup>.”
