# The Education Workforce Council (Membership and Appointment) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2018

#### Title and commencement

- **1.**—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Education Workforce Council (Membership and Appointment) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2018.
  - (2) These Regulations come into force on 9 August 2018.

### Amendment

- **2.** Schedule 2 to the Education Workforce Council (Membership and Appointment) (Wales) Regulations 2014(1) is amended as follows—
  - (a) in Part 1—
    - (i) for paragraph 1 substitute—

    - (ii) omit paragraph 7; and
  - (b) in Part 2, after paragraph 27 insert—
    - **"28.** Council for Wales of Voluntary Youth Services Cyngor Cymreig y Gwasanaethau Ieuenctid Gwirfoddol(2).
      - **29.** Wales Principal Youth Officers' Group(3).
      - **30.** National Training Federation for Wales Ltd(4).
      - **31.** Education Training Standards Wales(5)."
