The A470 Trunk Road (South of Dolwyddelan, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians)
Order 2018

Made 5 September 2018

Coming into force 10 September 2018

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (South of Dolwyddelan, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 10 September 2018.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A470 Maentwrog to East of Conwy Trunk Road south of Dolwyddelan, Conwy County Borough that extends from its junction with Pont Rufeinig to the Conwy/Gwynedd county boundary;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 10:00 hours on 10 September 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
