**The A487 Trunk Road (Corris
Uchaf to Minffordd, Gwynedd)
(Temporary Prohibition of Large
Vehicles) Order 2019**

Made 11 November 2019

Coming into force 19 November 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (Corris Uchaf to Minffordd, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Large Vehicles) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 19 November 2019.

2. In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road between Corris Uchaf and Minffordd that extends from its junction

with the B4405 at Minffordd to a point 1400 metres south of that junction;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 21:00 on the 19 November 2019 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle exceeding 2.5 metres in width, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road specified in this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 6 months.
