**The Smoke Control Areas (Exempted  
Classes of Fireplace) (Wales) Order 2019**

The Welsh Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 21(5) of the Clean Air Act 1993<sup>(1)</sup>.

The Welsh Ministers are satisfied that the fireplaces exempted by this Order can be used for burning fuel other than authorised fuels without producing any smoke or a substantial quantity of smoke.
