Enforcement

Powers relating to travel restrictions

^{X1}29.—(1) Paragraph (2) applies where an enforcement officer has reasonable grounds for suspecting that a person is about to enter an area in contravention of—

- (a) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 1,
- (b) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 2,
- (c) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 3, or
- (d) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 4.
- (2) The enforcement officer may direct the person not to enter the area.

(3) Paragraph (4) applies where an enforcement officer has reasonable grounds for suspecting that a person is in an area in contravention of—

- (a) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 1,
- (b) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 2,
- (c) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 3, or
- (d) paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 4.
- (4) The enforcement officer may-
 - (a) direct the person to leave the area;
 - (b) remove the person from the area.

(5) Paragraph (6) applies where an enforcement officer has reasonable grounds for suspecting that a person is about to leave an area in contravention of—

- (a) paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 1,
- (b) paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 2, or
- (c) paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 3.
- (6) The enforcement officer may direct the person not to leave the area.

(7) Paragraph (8) applies where an enforcement officer has reasonable grounds for suspecting that a person has left an area in contravention of—

- (a) paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 1,
- (b) paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 2, or
- (c) paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 3.

- (8) The enforcement officer may—
 - (a) direct the person to return to the area;
 - (b) return the person to the area.
