Prohibition on organising events

- **4.**—[F¹[F²(1) No person may, without a reasonable excuse, be involved in organising an event [F³held to any extent indoors.]]
- (1A) For the purposes of this paragraph, a person working, or providing voluntary services, in relation to the holding of an event is not to be treated as attending the event.]
 - [F4(2) Sub-paragraph (1) does not apply to a person involved in organising—
 - (a) an event held at a private dwelling at which people do not participate in a gathering in contravention of [F5 regulation 37(2)];
 - (b) an event authorised by the Welsh Ministers under paragraph 5;

 - (f) a regulated gathering that takes place to any extent indoors and at which—
 - (i) no more than 30 people are in attendance, ^{F9}... and
 - (ii) no alcohol is consumed;

 - (h) a regulated gathering ^{FII}... for the development or well-being of children (including sports, music and other recreational activities such as those provided for children outside of school hours and during school holidays).
 - [F12(i)] an event that is held at regulated premises, other than at holiday or travel accommodation, and at which—
 - (i) no more than 6 people are in attendance, or
 - (ii) all of the people in attendance are members of the same household;
 - (j) an event that is any of the following, where it is held in premises ordinarily used for that purpose—
 - (i) the showing of a film,
 - (ii) an entertainment performance where no more than 200 people are in attendance F13...,
 - (iii) a market, or
 - (iv) a religious service;
