**The A466 Trunk Road (Between
Newhouse Interchange and
Highbeech Roundabout, Chepstow,
Monmouthshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles and
Cyclists) Order 2020**

Made 4 August 2020

Coming into force 6 August 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A466 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the roads.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A466 Trunk Road (Between Newhouse Interchange and Highbeech Roundabout, Chepstow, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and Cyclists) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 6 August 2020.

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672 and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“the trunk road” (“*y cefnffyrdd*”) means the A466 London to Fishguard Trunk Roads that extends from a point 85 metres north-west of the centre-point of Newhouse Interchange to a point 35 metres south-east of the centre-point of Highbeech Roundabout;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 7 September 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.

Application

5. The prohibitions in articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.
