ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A4232 Trunk Road (Junction 33 (Capel Llanilltern) to Culverhouse Cross, Cardiff) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020

Made 20 August 2020

Coming into force 22 August 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A4232 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A4232 Trunk Road (Junction 33 (Capel Llanilltern) to Culverhouse Cross, Cardiff) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 22 August 2020.

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A4232 London to Fishguard trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 20:00 on the 22 August 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The entire length of the A4232 northbound entry slip road at Culverhouse Cross Interchange.
- 2. The length of the A4232 northbound carriageway that extends from a point 352 metres northwest of the centre-point of Culverhouse Cross to its junction with the circulatory carriageway of J33 Capel Llanilltern.
- 3. The entire length of the A4232 southbound exit slip road at Culverhouse Cross Interchange.
- 4. The length of the southbound carriageway of the A4232 that extends from its junction with the circulatory carriageway of J33 Capel Llanilltern (including the southbound dedicated lane) to a point 352 metres northwest of the centre-point of Culverhouse Cross.
