ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A458 Trunk Road (Salop Road, Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020

Made 1 September 2020

Coming into force 7 September 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A458 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and/or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Salop Road, Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 7 September 2020.

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services, public service buses and school buses or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau Trunk Road in the

County of Powys that extends extends from the centre-point of its junction with the A483 to the centre-point of the junction to access the Rhallt Nursing Home;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 09:00 hours on 7 September 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
