NODYN ESBONIADOL

(Nid yw'r nodyn hwn yn rhan o'r Gorchymyn)

Mae'r Gorchymyn hwn yn gweithredu argymhellion Comisiwn Ffiniau a Democratiaeth Leol Cymru ("y Comisiwn"), a roddodd adroddiad ym mis Gorffennaf 2019 ar ei adolygiad o drefniadau etholiadol Sir Benfro. Roedd Adroddiad y Comisiwn yn cynnig lleihau nifer y wardiau etholiadol o 60 i 59, ond argymhellwyd bod nifer y cynghorwyr yn parhau yn 60.

Mae'r Gorchymyn hwn yn gweithredu argymhellion y Comisiwn, gydag addasiadau.

Mae erthygl 3 o'r Gorchymyn hwn yn diddymu'r trefniadau etholiadol presennol ar gyfer Sir Benfro ac yn cyflwyno'r Atodlen sy'n nodi'r trefniadau etholiadol newydd ar gyfer Sir Benfro.

Mae'r Gorchymyn hwn hefyd yn gweithredu argymhellion ynghylch newidiadau i drefniadau etholiadol ar gyfer rhai cymunedau yn Sir Benfro.

Mae erthygl 4 yn gwneud newidiadau i'r ffiniau rhwng wardiau cymunedol Hakin, Hubberston, Canol Aberdaugleddau, Gogledd Aberdaugleddau a Dwyrain Aberdaugleddau yng nghymuned Aberdaugleddau.

Mae erthyglau 5 a 6 yn gwneud newidiadau i'r ffin rhwng wardiau cymunedol St Michael a De St Mary yng nghymuned Penfro, ac i nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros y wardiau hyn.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order implements the recommendations of the Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales ("the Commission"), which reported in July 2019 on its review of the electoral arrangements for the County of Pembrokeshire. The Commission's Report proposed a reduction in the number of electoral wards from 60 to 59, but recommended the number of councillors to remain at 60.

This Order implements the Commission's recommendations, with modifications.

Article 3 of this Order abolishes the existing electoral arrangements for the County of Pembrokeshire and introduces the Schedule, which sets out the new electoral arrangements for the County of Pembrokeshire.

This Order also implements recommendations for changes to the electoral arrangements for some communities within the County of Pembrokeshire.

Article 4 makes changes to the boundaries between the community wards of Hakin, Hubberston, Central, North and East within the community of Milford Haven.

Articles 5 and 6 make changes to the boundary between the community wards of St Michael and St Mary South within the community of Pembroke, and to the number of members to be elected for these wards.

Mae erthygl 7 yn diddymu wardiau cymunedol Canol Doc Penfro a Llanion yng nghymuned Doc Penfro, ac yn creu wardiau cymunedol newydd Canol Doc Penfro a Bush.

Mae erthygl 8 yn diddymu ward gymunedol Pennar yng nghymuned Doc Penfro, ac yn creu wardiau cymunedol newydd Pennar a Bufferland.

Mae erthygl 9 yn nodi nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros wardiau newydd Bufferland, Bush a Phennar yng nghymuned Doc Penfro, ac yn gwneud newidiadau i nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward Canol Doc Penfro.

Mae erthygl 10 yn creu wardiau cymunedol newydd Gogledd Saundersfoot a De Saundersfoot yng nghymuned Saundersfoot. Mae erthygl 11 yn nodi nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros y wardiau newydd hyn.

Ystyriwyd Cod Ymarfer Gweinidogion Cymru ar gynnal Asesiadau Effaith Rheoleiddiol mewn perthynas â'r Gorchymyn hwn. O ganlyniad, ystyriwyd nad oedd yn angenrheidiol cynnal asesiad effaith rheoleiddiol o'r costau a'r manteision sy'n debygol o ddeillio o gydymffurfio â'r Gorchymyn hwn.

Mae printiau o'r mapiau a labelwyd "1" i "10" y mae'r Gorchymyn hwn yn ymwneud â hwy wedi eu hadneuo yn swyddfeydd Llywodraeth Cymru ym Mharc Cathays, Caerdydd, CF10 3NQ (yr Is-adran Democratiaeth Llywodraeth Leol), a chyda Chyngor Sir Penfro. Mae'r printiau sydd wedi eu hadneuo gyda Chyngor Sir Penfro yn agored i gael eu harchwilio gan unrhyw un y bydd darpariaethau'r Gorchymyn hwn yn effeithio arnynt.

Article 7 abolishes the community wards of Central and Llanion within the community of Pembroke Dock, and creates the new community wards of Central and Bush.

Article 8 abolishes the community ward of Pennar within the community of Pembroke Dock, and creates the new community wards of Pennar and Bufferland.

Article 9 set outs the number of members to be elected for the new wards of Bufferland, Bush and Pennar in the community of Pembroke Dock, and makes changes to the number of members to be elected for the Central ward.

Article 10 creates the new community wards of Saundersfoot North and Saundersfoot South in the community of Saundersfoot. Article 11 sets out the number of members to be elected for these new wards.

The Welsh Ministers' Code of Practice on the carrying out of Regulatory Impact Assessments was considered in relation to this Order. As a result, it was not considered necessary to carry out a regulatory impact assessment as to the likely costs and benefits of complying with this Order.

Prints of the maps labelled "1" to "10" to which this Order relates are deposited in the office of the Welsh Government at Cathays Park, Cardiff, CF10 3NQ (Local Government Democracy Division), and with Pembrokeshire County Council. Prints deposited with Pembrokeshire County Council are open to inspection by anyone affected by the provisions of this Order.

Mae Comisiwn Ffiniau a Democratiaeth Leol Cymru(1), yn unol ag adran 36(5) o Ddeddf Llywodraeth Leol (Democratiaeth) (Cymru) 2013(2) (“Deddf 2013”), wedi cyflwyno i Weinidogion Cymru adroddiad dyddiedig Gorffennaf 2019 yn cynnwys ei argymhellion ar gyfer newid a manylion ei adolygiad o’r trefniadau etholiadol ar gyfer Sir Benfro.

The Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales(1) has, in accordance with section 36(5) of the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013(2) (“the 2013 Act”), submitted to the Welsh Ministers a report dated July 2019 containing its recommendations for change and the details of its review of the electoral arrangements for the County of Pembrokeshire.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, ar ôl ystyried y materion y cyfeirir atynt ac a nodir yn adran 37(2)(a) ac (c) o Ddeddf 2013, wedi penderfynu rhoi effaith i’r argymhellion hynny gydag addasiadau.

The Welsh Ministers have, after consideration of the matters referred to and set out in section 37(2)(a) and (c) of the 2013 Act, decided to give effect to those recommendations with modifications.

Yn unol ag adran 37(3) o Ddeddf 2013, mae mwy na 6 wythnos wedi mynd heibio ers i’r argymhellion hynny gael eu cyflwyno i Weinidogion Cymru.

In accordance with section 37(3) of the 2013 Act, more than 6 weeks have elapsed since those recommendations were submitted to the Welsh Ministers.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru yn gwneud y Gorchymyn a ganlyn drwy arfer eu pwerau a roddir gan adran 37(1) o Ddeddf 2013.

The Welsh Ministers make the following Order in exercise of their powers conferred by section 37(1) of the 2013 Act.

(1) Sefydlwyd y Comisiwn Ffiniau Llywodraeth Leol i Gymru gan adran 53 o Ddeddf Llywodraeth Leol 1972 (p. 70) (“Deddf 1972”) ac Atodlen 8 iddi. Diddymwyd adran 53 ac Atodlen 8 gan adran 73(2) o Ddeddf Llywodraeth Leol (Democratiaeth) (Cymru) 2013 (dccc 4) (“Deddf 2013”) ac Atodlen 2 iddi. Mae Deddf 2013 yn ailenwi’r Comisiwn Ffiniau Llywodraeth Leol i Gymru yn Gomisiwn Ffiniau a Democratiaeth Leol Cymru (gweler adran 2).

(1) The Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales was established by section 53 of, and Schedule 8 to, the Local Government Act 1972 (c. 70) (“the 1972 Act”). Section 53 and Schedule 8 were repealed by section 73(2) of, and Schedule 2 to, the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013 (anaw 4) (“the 2013 Act”). The 2013 Act re-names the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales as the Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales (see section 2).

(2) 2013 dccc 4.

(2) 2013 anaw 4.

Enwi a chychwyn

1.—(1) Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Sir Benfro (Trefniadau Etholiadol) 2021.

(2) At unrhyw ddiben a nodir yn rheoliad 4(1) o'r Rheoliadau, daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym drennydd y diwrnod y'i gwneir.

(3) At bob diben arall, daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar y diwrnod arferol ar gyfer ethol cynghorwyr yn 2022(1).

Dehongli

2. Yn y Gorchymyn hwn—

ystyr “y Rheoliadau” (“*the Regulations*”) yw Rheoliadau Newidiadau i Ardaloedd Llywodraeth Leol 1976(2);

ystyr “ward etholiadol” (“*electoral ward*”) yw unrhyw ardal yr etholir aelodau drosti i Gyngor Sir Penfro;

mae unrhyw gyfeiriad at fap yn golygu un o'r 10 map a farciwyd “Map o Orchymyn Sir Benfro (Trefniadau Etholiadol) 2021” a adnewwyd yn unol â rheoliad 5 o'r Rheoliadau ac a labelwyd “1” i “10”, ac mae cyfeiriad at fap â rhif yn gyfeiriad at y map sy'n dwyn y rhif hwnnw;

pan ddangosir bod ffin ar fap yn rhedeg ar hyd ffordd, rheilffordd, troetffordd, cwrs dŵr neu nodwedd ddaearyddol debyg, mae i'w thrin fel un sy'n rhedeg ar hyd llinell ganol y nodwedd;

mae i eiriau ac ymadroddion a ddefnyddir yn y Gorchymyn hwn yr un ystyr ag a roddir iddynt yn Rhan 3 o Ddeddf Llywodraeth Leol (Democratiaeth) (Cymru) 2013, ac eithrio i'r graddau yr ymddengys bwriad i'r gwrthwyneb.

Trefniadau etholiadol ar gyfer Sir Benfro

3.—(1) Mae wardiau etholiadol Sir Benfro, fel y maent yn bodoli yn union cyn y diwrnod arferol ar gyfer ethol cynghorwyr yn 2022, wedi eu diddymu.

(2) Mae Sir Benfro wedi ei rhannu'n 59 o wardiau etholiadol a phob un ohonynt yn dwyn yr enw Saesneg a restrir yng nghlofn 1 a'r enw Cymraeg a restrir yng nghlofn 2 o'r Tabl yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

(1) Mae Gorchymyn Awdurdodau Lleol (Newid Blynyddoedd Etholiadau Cyffredin) (Cymru) 2019 (O.S. 2019/1269 (Cy. 220)) yn diwygio adran 26(1) o Ddeddf 1972 i ddarparu y bydd etholiadau cyffredin cynghorwyr awdurdodau lleol yn cael eu cynnal yn y flwyddyn 2022 yn hytrach na 2021.

(2) O.S. 1976/246. Mae adran 74(3) o Ddeddf 2013 yn darparu bod y Rheoliadau yn parhau i gael effaith mewn perthynas â gorchymynion a wnaed o dan Ran 3 o Ddeddf 2013, fel pe bai'r gorchymynion hynny wedi eu gwneud o dan Ran 4 o Ddeddf 1972.

Title and commencement

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the County of Pembrokeshire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 2021.

(2) For any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) of the Regulations, this Order comes into force on the second day after the day on which it is made.

(3) For all other purposes, this Order comes into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2022(1).

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“electoral ward” (“*ward etholiadol*”) means any area for which members are elected to Pembrokeshire County Council;

“the Regulations” (“*y Rheoliadau*”) means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(2);

any reference to a map means one of the 10 maps marked “Map of the County of Pembrokeshire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 2021” deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the Regulations, labelled “1” to “10”, and a reference to a numbered map is a reference to the map that bears that number;

where a boundary is shown on a map as running along a road, railway line, footway, watercourse or similar geographical feature, it is to be treated as running along the centre line of the feature;

words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as they have in Part 3 of the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013, except so far as a contrary intention appears.

Electoral arrangements for the County of Pembrokeshire

3.—(1) The electoral wards of the County of Pembrokeshire, as they exist immediately before the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2022, are abolished.

(2) The County of Pembrokeshire is divided into 59 electoral wards each bearing the English language name listed in column 1 and the Welsh language name listed in column 2 of the Table in the Schedule to this Order.

(1) The Local Authorities (Change to the Years of Ordinary Elections) (Wales) Order 2019 (S.I. 2019/1269 (W. 220)) amends section 26(1) of the 1972 Act to provide that the year in which the ordinary elections of councillors of local authorities shall take place is 2022 instead of 2021.

(2) S.I. 1976/246. Section 74(3) of the 2013 Act provides that the Regulations continue to have effect in relation to orders made under Part 3 of the 2013 Act, as if those orders were made under Part 4 of the 1972 Act.

(3) Mae pob ward etholiadol yn cynnwys yr ardaloedd a bennir mewn perthynas â'r ward etholiadol honno yng ngholofn 3 o'r Tabl yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

(4) Nifer aelodau'r cyngor sydd i'w hethol dros bob ward etholiadol yw'r nifer a bennir yng ngholofn 4 o'r Tabl yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

(5) Mae'r darpariaethau yn y Gorchymyn hwn yn cymryd blaenoriaeth dros unrhyw ddarpariaeth wrthdrawiadol mewn unrhyw offeryn statudol blaenorol a wnaed o dan adran 58(2) o Ddeddf Llywodraeth Leol 1972(1).

Cymuned Aberdaugleddau: newidiadau i wardiau cymunedol

4. Yng nghymuned Aberdaugleddau—

- (a) mae'r rhan o ward Hakin a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 1 wedi ei throsglwyddo i ward Canol Aberdaugleddau;
- (b) mae'r rhan o ward Hubberston a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 2 wedi ei throsglwyddo i ward Hakin;
- (c) mae'r rhan o ward Gogledd Aberdaugleddau a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 3 wedi ei throsglwyddo i ward Dwyrain Aberdaugleddau.

Cymuned Penfro: newidiadau i wardiau cymunedol

5. Mae'r rhan o ward gymunedol St Michael o gymuned Penfro a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 4 wedi ei throsglwyddo i ward gymunedol De St Mary o gymuned Penfro.

Cymuned Penfro: newidiadau canlyniadol i drefniadau etholiadol

6. Yng nghymuned Penfro—

- (a) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward De St Mary yw 4;
- (b) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward St Michael yw 4.

(3) Each electoral ward comprises the areas specified in relation to that electoral ward in column 3 of the Table in the Schedule to this Order.

(4) The number of members of the council to be elected for each electoral ward is the number specified in column 4 of the Table in the Schedule to this Order.

(5) The provisions in this Order take precedence over any conflicting provision in any previous statutory instrument made under section 58(2) of the Local Government Act 1972(1).

The community of Milford Haven: changes to community wards

4. In the community of Milford Haven—

- (a) the part of the Hakin ward shown hatched on Map 1 is transferred to the Central ward;
- (b) the part of the Hubberston ward shown hatched on Map 2 is transferred to the Hakin ward;
- (c) the part of the North ward shown hatched on Map 3 is transferred to the East ward.

The community of Pembroke: changes to community wards

5. The part of the community ward of St Michael of the community of Pembroke shown hatched on Map 4 is transferred to the community ward of St Mary South of the community of Pembroke.

The community of Pembroke: consequential changes to electoral arrangements

6. In the community of Pembroke—

- (a) the number of members to be elected for the St Mary South ward is 4;
- (b) the number of members to be elected for the St Michael ward is 4.

(1) 1972 p. 70; diddymwyd adran 58 o Ddeddf 1972 gan adran 73(2) o Ddeddf 2013 ac Atodlen 2 iddi, yn ddarostyngedig i ddarpariaethau arbed a bennir yn adran 74 o Ddeddf 2013.

7.—(1) Mae wardiau cymunedol Canol Doc Penfro a Llanion yng nghymuned Doc Penfro, fel y maent yn bodoli yn union cyn y diwrnod arferol ar gyfer ethol cynghorwyr yn 2022, wedi eu diddymu.

(2) Mae'r wardiau cymunedol a ganlyn wedi eu ffurfio—

- (a) ward Canol Doc Penfro a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 5;
- (b) ward Bush a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 6.

Cymuned Doc Penfro: diddymu ward gymunedol Pennar a chreu wardiau cymunedol Pennar a Bufferland

8.—(1) Mae ward gymunedol Pennar yng nghymuned Doc Penfro, fel y mae'n bodoli yn union cyn y diwrnod arferol ar gyfer ethol cynghorwyr yn 2022, wedi ei diddymu.

(2) Mae'r wardiau cymunedol a ganlyn wedi eu ffurfio—

- (a) ward Pennar a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 7;
- (b) ward Bufferland a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 8.

Cymuned Doc Penfro: newidiadau canlyniadol i drefniadau etholiadol

9. Yng nghymuned Doc Penfro—

- (a) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward Bufferland yw 3;
- (b) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward Bush yw 3;
- (c) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward Canol Doc Penfro yw 4;
- (d) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward Pennar yw 3.

Cymuned Saundersfoot: creu wardiau cymunedol

10. Mae cymuned Saundersfoot i'w rhannu i ffurfio'r wardiau cymunedol a ganlyn—

- (a) ward Gogledd Saundersfoot a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 9;
- (b) ward De Saundersfoot a ddangosir â llinellau ar Fap 10.

The community of Pembroke Dock: abolition of the community wards of Central and Llanion and creation of the community wards of Central and Bush

7.—(1) The community wards of Central and Llanion of the community of Pembroke Dock, as they exist immediately before the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2022, are abolished.

(2) There are constituted the following community wards—

- (a) the Central ward shown hatched on Map 5;
- (b) the Bush ward shown hatched on Map 6.

The community of Pembroke Dock: abolition of the community ward of Pennar and creation of the community wards of Pennar and Bufferland

8.—(1) The community ward of Pennar of the community of Pembroke Dock, as it exists immediately before the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2022, is abolished.

(2) There are constituted the following community wards—

- (a) the Pennar ward shown hatched on Map 7;
- (b) the Bufferland ward shown hatched on Map 8.

The community of Pembroke Dock: consequential changes to electoral arrangements

9. In the community of Pembroke Dock—

- (a) the number of members to be elected for the Bufferland ward is 3;
- (b) the number of members to be elected for the Bush ward is 3;
- (c) the number of members to be elected for the Central ward is 4;
- (d) the number of members to be elected for the Pennar ward is 3.

The community of Saundersfoot: creation of community wards

10. The community of Saundersfoot is to be divided into the following community wards—

- (a) the Saundersfoot North ward shown hatched on Map 9;
- (b) the Saundersfoot South ward shown hatched on Map 10.

Cymuned Saundersfoot: newidiadau canlyniadol i drefniadau etholiadol

11. Yng nghymuned Saundersfoot—

- (a) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward Gogledd Saundersfoot yw 4;
- (b) nifer yr aelodau sydd i'w hethol dros ward De Saundersfoot yw 8.

The community of Saundersfoot: consequential changes to electoral arrangements

11. In the community of Saundersfoot—

- (a) the number of members to be elected for the Saundersfoot North ward is 4;
- (b) the number of members to be elected for the Saundersfoot South ward is 8.
