Mae'r gofynion a osodir gan y Rheoliadau Teithio Rhyngwladol yn ddarostyngedig i eithriadau, ac mae categorïau penodol o berson wedi eu hesemptio rhag gorffod cydymffurfio â gofynion penodol. Mae "teithwyr rheoliad 2A" yn gategori o berson sydd wedi ei esemptio rhag gofynion penodol. Mae'r categori hwnnw yn cynnwys teithwyr sydd wedi eu brechu a theithwyr o dan 18 oed.

Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio'r Rheoliadau Teithio Rhyngwladol er mwyn gwneud profion cyn ymadael yn ofynnol mewn perthynas â "teithwyr rheoliad 2A" sy'n 12 oed neu'n hŷn.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Health Protection (Coronavirus, International Travel) (Wales) Regulations 2020 (S.I. 2020/574 (W. 132)) ("the International Travel Regulations") and the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Public Health Information for Persons Travelling to Wales etc.) Regulations 2020 (S.I. 2020/595 (W. 136)) ("the Public Health Information Regulations").

The International Travel Regulations impose requirements on persons entering Wales after having been abroad. The requirements imposed by the International Travel Regulations are subject to exceptions, and certain categories of person are exempt from having to comply with certain requirements. "Regulation 2A travellers" are a category of person exempt from certain requirements. That category includes vaccinated travellers and travellers aged under 18.

These Regulations amend the International Travel Regulations so as to require pre-departure testing in relation to "regulation 2A travellers" aged 12 or over.

Mae rheoliad 4 o'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio'r Rheoliadau Gwybodaeth Iechyd y Cyhoedd o ganlyniad i'r diwygiadau a wneir i'r Rheoliadau Teithio Rhyngwladol.

Ystyriwyd Cod Ymarfer Gweinidogion Cymru ar gynnal Asesiadau Effaith Rheoleiddiol mewn perthynas â'r Rheoliadau hyn. O ganlyniad, ni luniwyd asesiad effaith rheoleiddiol o'r costau a'r manteision sy'n debygol o ddeillio o gydymffurfio â'r Rheoliadau hyn.

These Regulations also amend the time at which a pre-departure test must be taken to no more than 48 hours before departure.

Regulation 4 of these Regulations amends the Public Health Information Regulations in consequence of the amendments made to the International Travel Regulations.

The Welsh Ministers' Code of Practice on the carrying out of Regulatory Impact Assessments was considered in relation to these Regulations. As a result, a regulatory impact assessment has not been prepared as to the likely costs and benefits of complying with these Regulations.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 45B and 45P(2) of the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984(1), make the following Regulations.

## Title and coming into force

1.—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Health Protection (Coronavirus, International Travel and Public Health Information to Travellers) (Wales) (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 4) Regulations 2021.

(2) These Regulations come into force at 4.00 a.m. on 7 December 2021.

“Essential information to enter Wales from overseas

Take a PCR or LFD test within 2 days of departure to Wales. You must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test result when you depart for Wales from outside the CTA. This includes UK nationals and residents, and people who qualify as fully vaccinated. Read more about COVID-19 testing before you travel to Wales [www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-testing-for-people-travelling-to-england](http://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-testing-for-people-travelling-to-england)

Fill in your Passenger Locator Form up to 48 hours before arrival. You must declare all countries you have visited or transited through in the 10 days prior to your arrival on your Passenger Locator Form.

Before departure, check the list of red list countries, as the list can change regularly.

Red list passengers (including passengers who are fully vaccinated)

1. Book a managed quarantine package
2. Complete a Passenger Locator Form

You can only enter if you are a British or Irish National, or you have residency rights in the UK. You must enter through a designated port and quarantine in a government approved hotel for 10 days.

Unvaccinated passengers or passengers vaccinated with unauthorised vaccines who are not red list passengers

1. Book PCR tests for day 2 and day 8
2. Complete a Passenger Locator Form
3. Make plans to self-isolate in private accommodation for 10 full days after arrival (or full duration of stay if less than 10 days)

## “SCHEDEULE

Regulations 3, 3A and 4

### Part 1

The information to be provided for the purposes of regulations 3(2)(a)(i), 3(2)(b)(i), 3(2)(c)(i), 3A(4)(b)(i) and 3A(4)(c) is—

“Essential information to enter Wales from overseas

Take a PCR or LFD test within 2 days of departure to Wales. You must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test result when you depart for Wales from outside the CTA. This includes UK nationals and residents, and people who qualify as fully vaccinated. Read more about COVID-19 testing before you travel to Wales [www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-testing-for-people-travelling-to-england](http://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-testing-for-people-travelling-to-england)

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Fully vaccinated passengers who are not red list passengers

1. Book a PCR test to take on or before day 2
2. Complete a Passenger Locator Form
3. Self-isolate on arrival and until the result of your day 2 test is known. You may only leave self-isolation if the test is negative.

These measures apply to all persons (including UK nationals and residents) arriving in Wales from outside the common travel area comprising the United Kingdom, Ireland, the Isle of Man, and the Channel Islands. The British Overseas Territories are not in the common travel area. Public health requirements may vary depending upon in which nation of the UK you are staying.
