**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 1
(Kingsland Roundabout), Holyhead
to Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike),
Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition
of Traffic) Order 2021**

Made 11 June 2021

Coming into force 16 June 2021

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 1 (Kingsland Roundabout), Holyhead to Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike), Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021 and this Order comes into force on 16 June 2021.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 London to Holyhead trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 16 June 2021 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

6. No equestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

7. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the eastern side of Kingsland Roundabout, Holyhead (Junction 1) to a point 280 metres east of Junction 2 (Tŷ Mawr Interchange), including the eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 1 and the eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Junction 2.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 270 metres west of Junction 2 (Tŷ Mawr Interchange) to a point 330 metres east of Junction 3 (Pencaledog Interchange), including the eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 2 and the eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Junction 3.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 300 metres west of Junction 3 (Pencaledog Interchange) to a point 280 metres east of Junction 4 (Dalar Hir Interchange), including the eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 3 and the eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Junction 4.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 320 metres west of Junction 4 (Dalar Hir Interchange) to a point 270 metres east of Junction 5 (Treban Interchange), including the eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 4 and the eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Junction 5.

The length of the westbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 370 metres east of Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike) to a point 270 metres west of Junction 5 (Treban Interchange), including the westbound entry slip road at Junction 6.
