The A489 Trunk Road (Heol Maengwyn, Machynlleth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2022

Made	26 October 2022
Coming into force	28 October 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A489 trunk road, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted with the Chief Officer of Dyfed-Powys Police and given public notice of their intention to make this Order in accordance with regulations 5(1) and 6(1) of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1990(**2**).

Title and Commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A489 Trunk Road (Heol Maengwyn, Machynlleth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2022 and it comes into force on 28 October 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("*y gefnffordd*") means the A489 Caersws to Machynlleth trunk road.

Prohibition of waiting

3. Except as provided in article 4, no person may cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order at any time on any day.

Exemptions

4. A person may cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order for so long as may be necessary to enable—

- (a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle to be used in connection with any of the following operations:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of the trunk road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the lengths of the trunk road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any electronic communications apparatus as defined in paragraph 5 of Schedule 3A to the Communications Act 2003(1);
- (d) the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory functions;
- (e) the vehicle to take petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the lengths of the trunk road;
- (f) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; or
- (g) the vehicle to stop when the person in control of it:
 - (i) is required by law to stop;
 - (ii) is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident;
 - (iii) is prevented from proceeding; or

(iv) is acting upon the direction, or with the permission, of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of trunk road on which waiting is prohibited

1.The length of the north side of the trunk road known as Heol Maengwyn, Machynlleth which extends from a point 45 metres east of the centre point of its junction with Garth Road to a point 95 metres east of said junction.

2.The length of the south side of the trunk road known as Heol Maengwyn, Machynlleth which extends from a point 44 metres east of the centre point of its junction with Forge Road to a point 82 metres east of that said junction.
